Temporary Anchorage Devices (TADs) in orthodontics in enhancing esthetics and function

Temporary anchorage devices have proven to be a useful armamentarium for dentists and orthodontists throughout the world. Now, cases which initially believed to be a surgical one can be treated without surgery with results as equivalent to the one that would have been obtained with surgery by using temporary anchorage devices. I will be showing an interesting case where surgery was one of the options provided to the patient but ultimately treated without surgery with the use of TADs. Interestingly, the same 6mm TADs were used first in the lower anterior segment for intrusion and later in the upper posterior segment for retraction of anterior segment as the patient was reluctant to use new sets of TADs (8mm) because of financial issues. The dramatic change in facial esthetics and function obtained by the use of TADs resulted in a very satisfied patient.
