Editorial Note for Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology

I am pleased to mention that during the year 2019, all issues of volume 8 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology during this year also brought out 33rd International Conference on Nanomaterials and Nanotechnology on Nanomaterials and Nanomedicine Technology Research conference proceedings, which consisted of ~ 14 abstracts.

The JCR Impact factor of Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology for the year 2019 was 0.391, while the current SJR index raised to 0.856. The H-index of the journal, however, increased to 12 and Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology ranked seventh among all journals in the field of Nanomaterials Sciences published in India, 22nd in Asia and 54th in the world.

During the calendar year 2019, Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology received a total of 76 papers, out of which 56 articles (73%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2019 around 20 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 3rd issues of Volume 8 published during the year 2019, a total of 5 articles were published (at an average of 5 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors all around the world. A total of 44 research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 51 articles published in volume 8. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks.

During the calendar year 2019, a total of 43 Editors, 57 Reviewers joined the board of Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Editor-in-Chief: Dr. Dennis W. Smith Jr, during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant Adina Bernice in bringing out issues of Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology in time. I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology, the office bearers for their support in bringing out yet another volume of Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 9 of Journal of Nanomaterials & Molecular Nanotechnology in scheduled time.
