



Assessment of knowledge, perception and use of hormonal contraceptives by some female undergraduate students

Abstract:

The reconcilability of conflicting interests and the manageability of the individual life-cycle constitute the core of the HRM paradigm. However, the articulation of these premises into the operational realm depends on their internalization by the HR employees.
