



Editorial Note for Journal of Women's Health, Issues and Care

I am pleased to mention about the Journal of Women's Health, Issues and Care that during the year 2019, all Issues of volume 8 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

Journal of Women's Health, Issues and Care is an open access, peer-reviewed, quarterly, multidisciplinary journal that considers articles on all aspects of the health and wellbeing of adolescent girls and women, with a particular focus on the physical, mental, and emotional health of women in developed and developing nations.

The Impact factor of JWHIC for the year 2019 was 0.65 and maintained this till now. JWHIC is constantly in the direction of improving the Impact factor and will soon reach a higher value.

During the calendar year 2019, JWHIC received a total of 32 papers, out of which 13 articles (40%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2019 around 19 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 6 issues of Volume 8 published during the year 2019, a total of 19 articles were published (at an average of 4 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors all around the world. A total of 68 research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 19 articles published in volume 8. And among all of these reviewers, Professor Shigeki Matsubara from Jichi Medical University, Japan, contributed his valuable time to every manuscript of the Journal of Women's Health, Issues and Care. I appreciate the efforts of Professor Shigeki Matsubara towards the Journal of Women's Health, Issues and Care.

During the calendar year 2019, a total of 4 Editors, 26 Reviewers joined the board of JWHIC and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Jie Hu, Editor-in-Chief during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, Evelyn Ross in bringing out issues of JWHIC in time.

I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of JWHIC, the office bearers for their support in bringing out yet another volume of JWHIC and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 9 of JWHIC in scheduled time.
