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Energy Alterations In The Formation And Treatment Of Scleroderma

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Abstract:

Introduction: Scleroderma is an uncommon sickness that hard and tight the skin and its connective tissues. Conventional Chinese Medicine (TCM) partners the illness with a Qi and Yang inadequacy and briskness prompting blood balance.

Purpose: The purpose of this study is to demonstrate that energy alterations have an influence on the formation of scleroderma and to propose an effective treatment using ancient medical tools, associated with Western standard treatment.

Methods: A case report of a female patient, 58 years of age, determined to have scleroderma, and in constant utilization of corticosteroids. The patient introduced a solidifying of the skin, with thin firm fingers, purpled at its tips, a few calcified stores in the glutes, and hips of solidified consistency. The patient expressed she felt more "rejuvenated, emotionally balanced, and happy."

Conclusion: The conclusion of this investigation is that scleroderma might be connected with vitality changes of Yin, Yang, Qi, and Blood and it is conceivable to make a fitting treatment rebalancing these energies.
