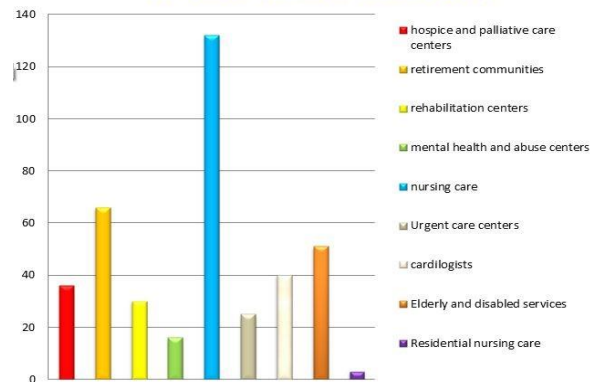

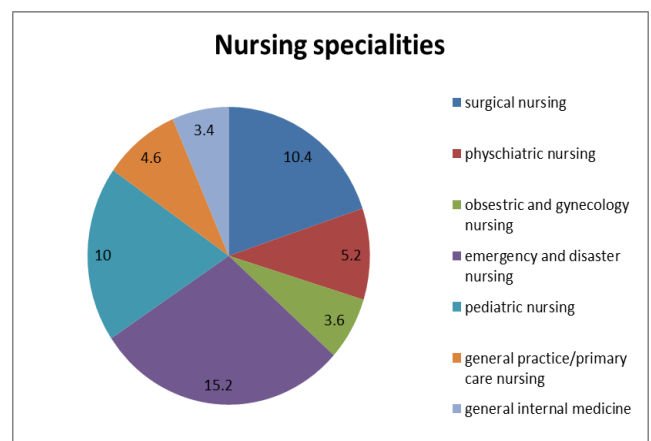

Revenue in billion dollars(USA)



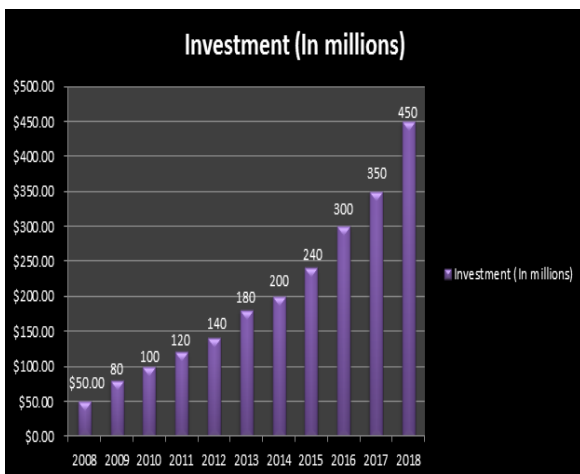
